This position will provide an opportunity for a TTC youth to explore salmon and fisheries-related work and to gain hands-on experience and training in this field of work. The incumbent should be comfortable working in both a field and office setting, and interacting with youth, community members, and Elders.

- Assisting with salmon restoration and monitoring field work activities
- Developing salmon-related educational materials and activities for community members and youth
- Working with the Teslin school to provide youth learning opportunities
- Assisting with in-season salmon management activities including updates to citizens

- Assisting with TTC culture camps planning and activities
- Keeping a journal of activities
