The following conditions must be abided by:

1. Prior to burning, the onus is on the permittee to verify the fire danger on the day(s) they are wanting to burn.
2. The permittee shall employ on site sufficient resources to ensure the fire will not escape control.
3. The fire must remain under supervision at all times until completely extinguished.
4. Burning is only permitted during periods of LOW Fire Danger.
5. Burning is not permitted during periods of MODERATE, HIGH or EXTREME Fire Danger.
6. All fires must be extinguished prior to the expiry date of the permit if the permit is suspended or canceled.
7. Fires must not be ignited or allowed to continue to burn when the wind is strong enough to cause flames or sparks to be carried to other combustible material.
8. Contact TTC Department of Lands and Resources prior to burning.
9. All fires must be at least 20 meters (approximately 66 feet) from standing trees.
10. No fire may have a footprint larger than 4 square meters (approximately 6 feet by 6 feet).
11. Only one fire is permitted at the site at one time.
12. All brush and grass must be cleared away from the burn pile for a distance of 5 meters (approximately 16 feet).
13. This permit is invalid for the burning of garbage or construction waste.
14. The permitted may be financially liable for fire suppression costs incurred by an out-of-control fire, as well as damages to neighboring properties.
